§ 1. THE GENEALOGY OF JESUS CHRIST

By the line of his reputed Father.

CHAP. I.

Historian.

- 1 **T**HE book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David,
2 the son of Abraham. Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac
3 begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judah and his brethren; and
4 Judah begat Pharez and Zarah of Thamar; and Pharez begat
5 Hefron; and Hefron begat Aram; and Aram begat Aminadab;
6 and Aminadab begat Nahshon; and Nahshon begat Salmon;
7 and Salmon begat Boaz of Rahab; and Boaz begat Obed
8 of Ruth; and Obed begat Jesse; and Jesse begat David the
9 king; and David the king begat Solomon of her *who had been*
10 *the wife of Uriah*; and Solomon begat Rehoboam; and Rehoboam
11 begat Abijah; and Abijah begat Afa; and Afa begat
12 Jehoshaphat; and Jehoshaphat begat Jehoram; and Jehoram
13 begat Uziah; and Uziah begat Jotham; and Jotham begat
14 Ahaz; and Ahaz begat Hezekiah; and Hezekiah begat Manasseh;
15 and Manasseh begat Amon; and Amon begat Josiah;
16 and Josiah begat Jehoiakim; and Jehoiakim begat Jechoniah
and his brethren, about the time they were carried away to
17 Babylon. And after they were brought to Babylon, Jechoniah
begat Salathiel; and Salathiel begat Zerubbabel; and Zerubbabel
begat Abiud; and Abiud begat Eliakim; and Eliakim
begat Azor; and Azor begat Zadoc; and Zadoc begat Achim;
and Achim begat Eliud; and Eliud begat Eleazar; and Eleazar
begat Matthan; and Matthan begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Joseph
the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus, who is called Christ.
- 17 So all the generations from Abraham to David *are* fourteen generations; and from David to the carrying away to Babylon *are* fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon to the Messiah *are* fourteen generations.
