Translation by Gerrit Verkuyl from Greek (Tischendorf 8th) (NT). Old Testament released in 1959, the New Testament in 1945. Verkuyl was the leader of a committee. Revised in 1946 (41 corrections, according to Chamberlin) and again in 1947.

Example Scriptures: To which Jesus replied, I am the Way and the Truth and the Life; no one comes to the Father except through Me. (John 14:6); All Scripture is inspired of God and is profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be well-fitted and adequately equipped for all good work. (2 Timothy 3:16-17).
