

THE GOSPEL *of* MARK

Wycliffe-Purvey, 1395

Chapter 1

1:1 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

1:2 As it is written in Esaias, the prophet, Lo! I send mine angel before thy face, that shall make thy way ready before thee.

1:3 The voice of a crier in desert, Make ye ready the way of the Lord, make ye his paths right. [The voice of *one* crying in desert, Make ye ready the way of the Lord, make ye his paths rightful.]

1:4 John was in desert baptizing, and preaching the baptism of penance, into remission of sins.

1:5 And all the country of Judaea went out to him, and all men of Jerusalem; and they were baptized of him in the flume Jordan [and were baptized of him in the flood of Jordan], acknowledging their sins.

1:6 And John was clothed with hairs of camels, and a girdle of skin *was* about his loins; and he ate honeysuckles, and wild honey, [+And John was clothed with hairs of camel, and a girdle of skin about his
